## Integrate and Innovate with CMIS!

Classical document and enterprise content management (ECM) is an old hat and reaching its limits. Enterprises as well as government organizations need fast access to all their crucial information, no matter where it is actually stored. The Organization for the Advancement of Structured Information Standards (OASIS) has lately released the new standard for Content Management Interoperability Services. CMIS will lead to business applications providing exactly that: One unified work environment for data, documents and processes independent from the underlying back end systems.

### ▶ CMIS - A Definition

Content Management Interoperability Services are a standard for improving interoperability between Enterprise Content Management systems. CMIS uses Web services and Web 2.0 interfaces to enable rich information to be shared across internet protocols in vendor-neutral formats, among document systems, publishers and repositories, within one enterprise and between companies. CMIS is not a new ECM interface; furthermore it defines a way to abstract the structure of any content repository into a common framework. Thus, content-centric applications can be developed in a repository independent manner. The focus is no longer set on technical possibilities but on business needs. Working with several repositories at once with one single user interface will soon be the normal case.

### ▶ WeWebU's Part

WeWebU is a member of the OASIS CMIS Technical Committee that defines the new standard. Even before joining the OASIS CMIS TC, WeWebU's products have combined data and processes from a wide range of ECM platforms in one unified, process-oriented work environment. With CMIS, WeWebU



OpenWorkdesk and WeWebU Zero-Install Office Integration are interoperable with almost every ECM system and usable in a wide range of cross-repository scenarios now.

### ▶ Outlook

CMIS will lead in the direction of overall Enterprise Information Management that replaces distinct solutions for managing data, contents and processes discretely. It is not a pie in the sky that documents and business processes from different ECM and Business Process Management (BPM) systems will go hand in hand with data from different data bases and business applications like ERP, CRM and Business Intelligence (BI) systems.
